We enjoyed painting silhouette safari pictures using water colours to decorate our classrooms and cloakroom!



To finish, we have had fun creating our own African animal and writing an information text about them to create a class book.


In Y1 maths, we have been learning all about measure.




objects too!

We discussed what the term 'private' means and why we have private parts of our body.


In RHE,

How to throw , javelins, nerf throwers and beanbags for distance.


How to jump for distance and for height.








In computing, we have been programming quizzes. The children used scratch junior to design an algorithm that answered a question.
