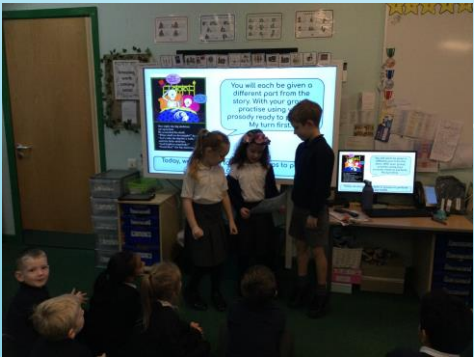
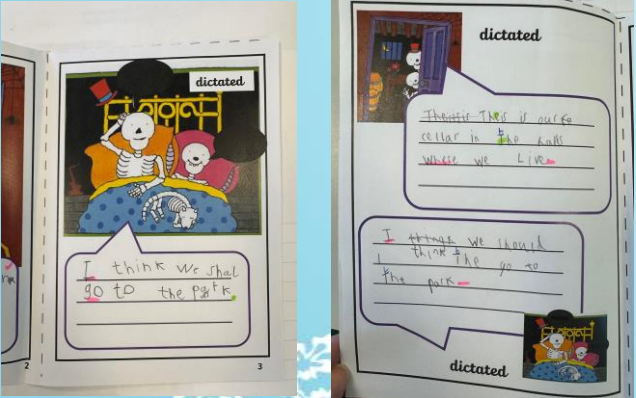
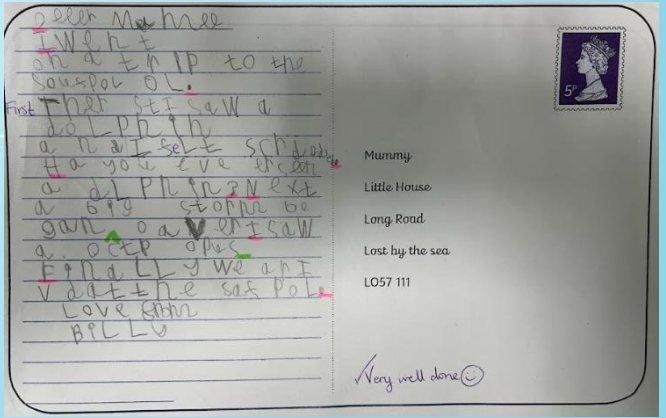
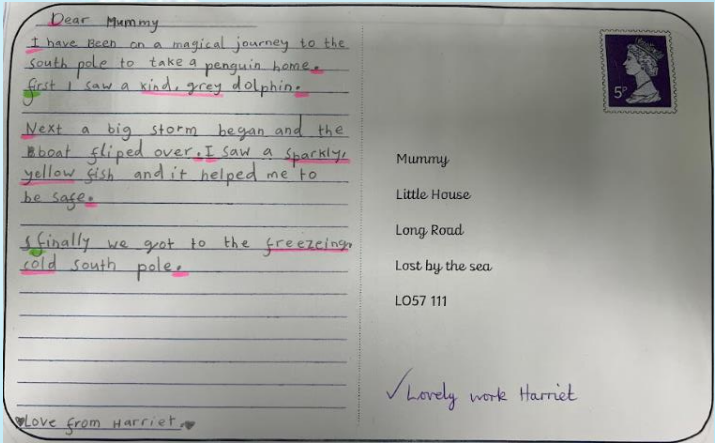
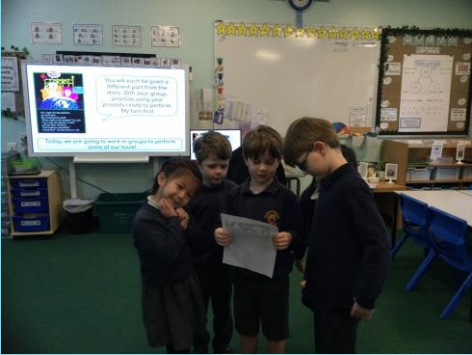
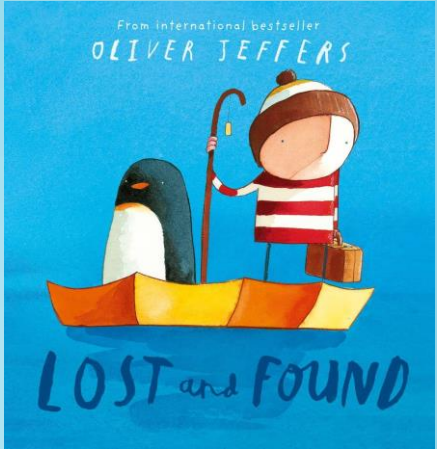
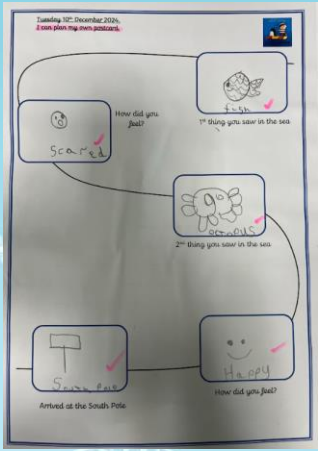
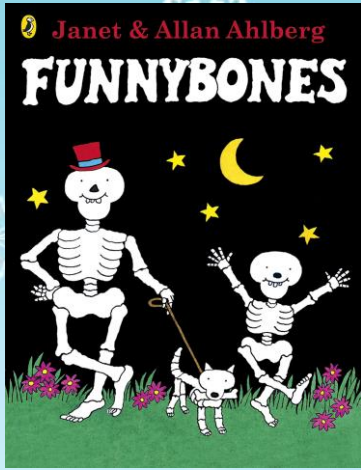


Y1/2 Autumn Term 2 2024-2025

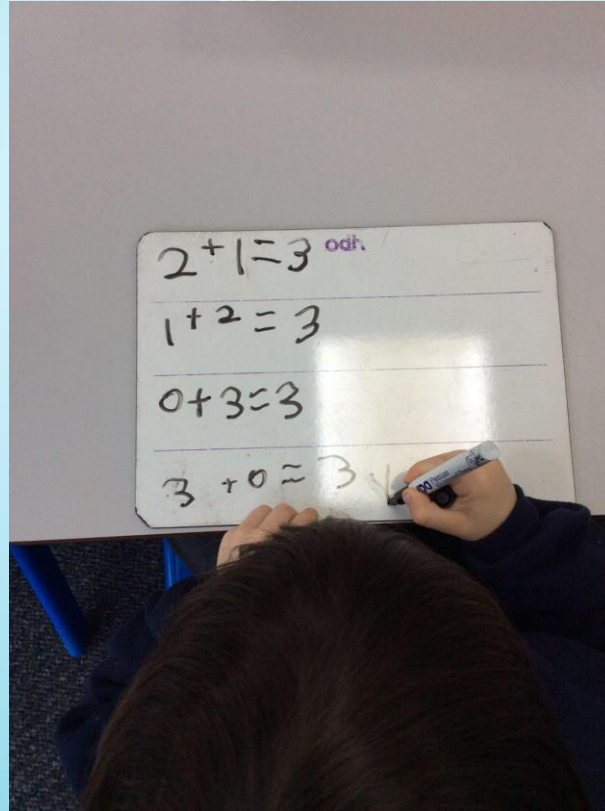
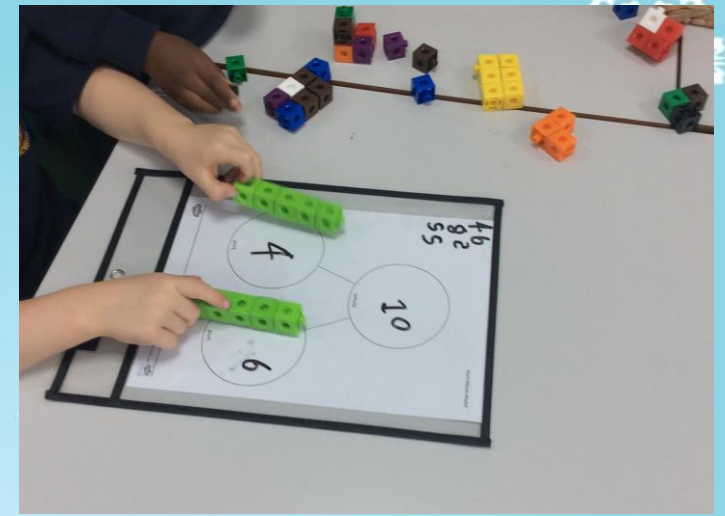


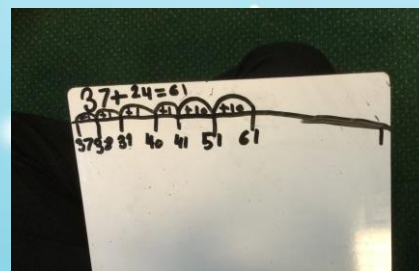
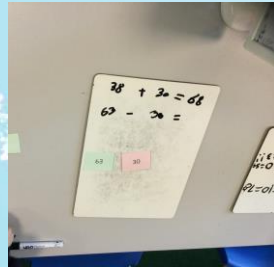
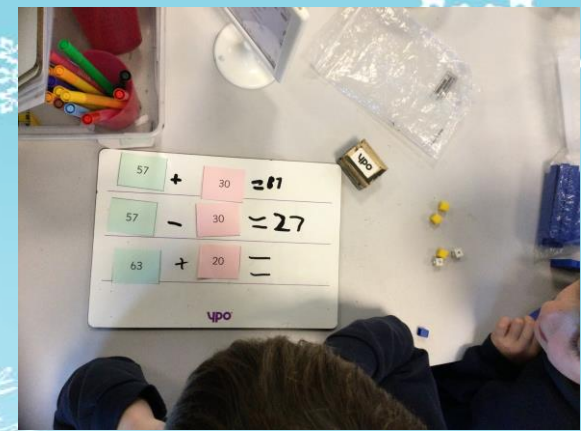
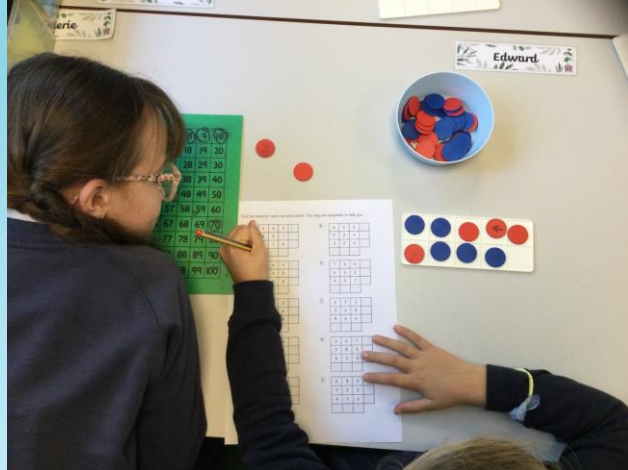
In English, we have enjoyed exploring the texts Funnybones and Lost and Found. We used captions to write our own Funnybones booklets.



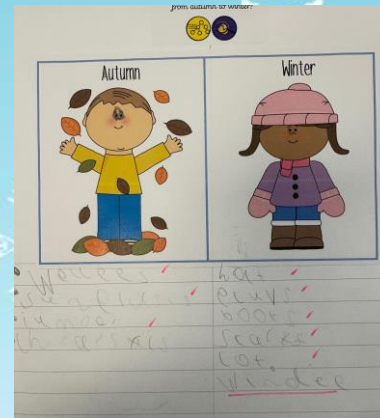
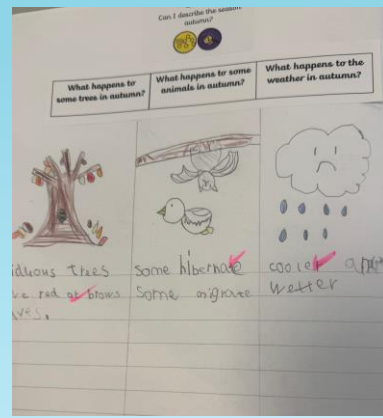
We then wrote postcards based on the text Lost and Found from the South Pole. Take a look at our wonderful postcards!

What is a meteorologist?
Meteorologists collect and study data from the atmosphere and oceans to make weather forecasts and carry out research.



Animals in Winter Hibernate

The weather changes in the winter. It has become cold. Food is hard to find. Some animals hibernate to save energy. During hibernation, an animal's heart rate and breathing slow down.

Animals hibernate in many different places.

- Caves.
- Dens.
- Hollow trees.
- Logs.
- Underground burrows.

Many different types of animals hibernate in the winter. Some animals hibernate briefly, while others hibernate the entire winter.

Animals in Winter Migrate

Some animals move to warmer places as the weather changes in winter. This is called migration.

Some animals that migrate in winter are:

- Monarch butterflies.
- Whales.
- Caribou.
- Canadian geese.

Animals in Winter Adapt

Some animals adapt during the winter. They may change their behavior, body temperature, or appearance to help them survive. One example of adaptation is the snowshoe hare changing colors to match its environment in the winter.

Some animals that adapt in winter are:

- Foxes.
- Deer.
- Squirrel.

We found out about the Nativity story and retold different parts using drama and sequencing activities.



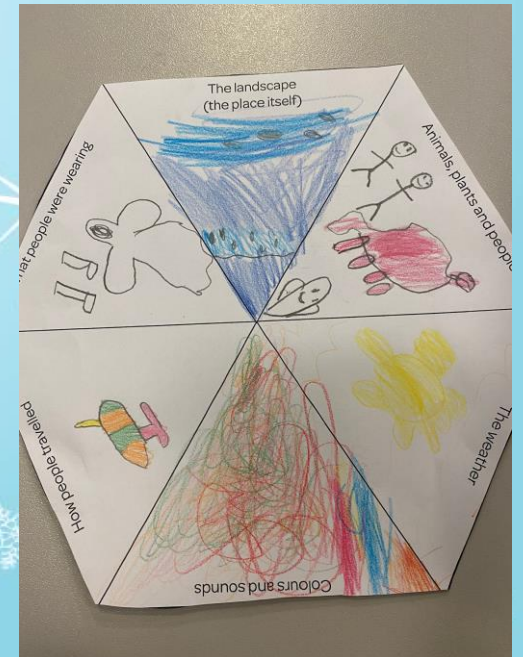
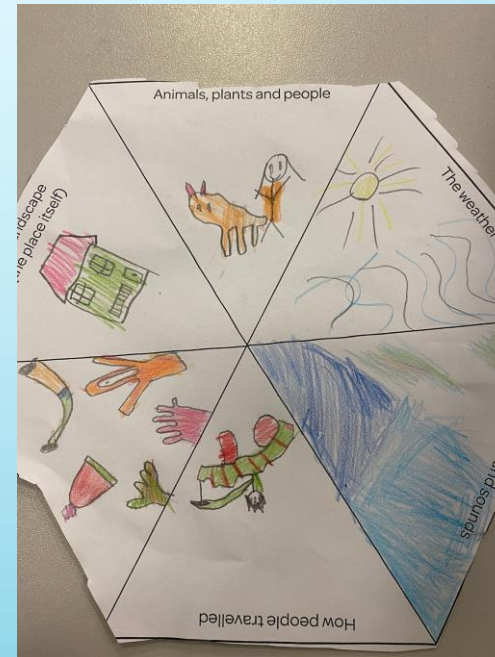
In Geography, we have been learning about weather and climate. We have used our previous knowledge about continents and the equator to identify hot, cold and temperate climates.



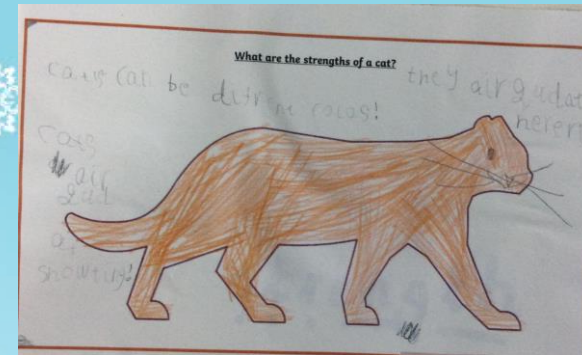
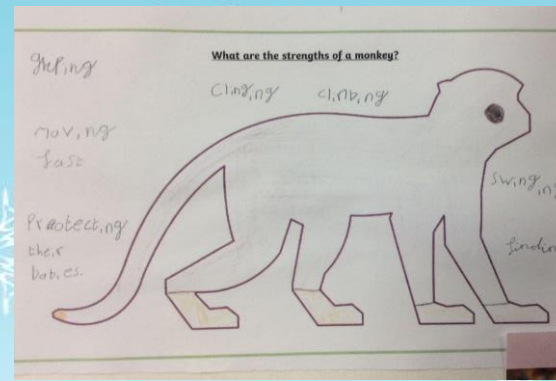

We played lots of listening and speaking games with our Autumn leaves and made some beautiful artwork.



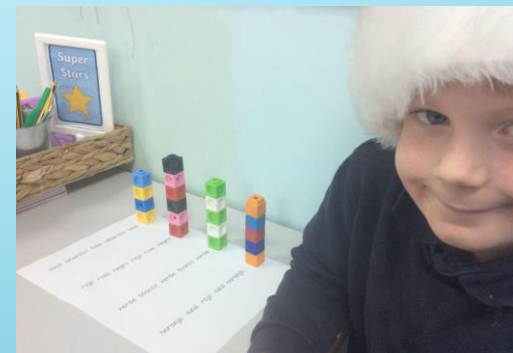
We learnt this song to help us remember all the colours. Have a sing-a-long at home!

We had the most amazing time performing our nativity 'A Bundle of Joy'.

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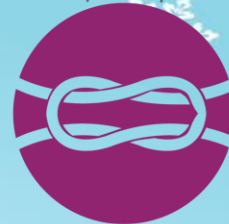
